

DataTag USB Flash Drive

DataTag is designed to store all of your emergency contact and medical information on a USB flash drive which fits securely on a necklace. Upload your vital medical information, including medications, allergies, emergency contacts, X-rays and MRI scans, direct from your computer onto a tiny 512 MB USB flash drive that works with any Windows computer. Your information can be accessed by doctors and medical technicians wherever you are, anywhere in the world.

Each DataTag features the universal medical alert symbol that first responders are trained to look for on the front of the tag. The back contains the Spondylitis Association of America's logo and the words "*Brittle Spine Disease*" to alert medical technicians and doctors to take special care to protect your spine during transport and treatment.

And you don't need to be a computer expert to use it. Here's how it works:

Simply remove the DataTag from its case and plug it into your computer's USB port. The software will start up and lead you through all of the steps necessary to enter your pertinent information. If you have X-rays or MRI images to include, just scan them in to the appropriate section of the form. When you're finished, just snap it back into its case and slip it around your neck.

DataTag ensures that you or your loved one will receive the best possible care in the event of an emergency.
